Ramadan is also about sharing and giving, and so to start off this month I would love to share


To mark the end of Ramadan, we have a 3 day morning prayer at our Mosque, gather with friends and family and give gifts.





# Happy Ramadani


The Islamic calendar is a lunar calendar following the monthly cycles of the moon's phases. The sighting of the crescent moon marks the start of the holy month of Ramadan.
